Tête-à-têtes are perfect for enjoying take-out with a friend or taking shelter from the sun and will be placed along the sidewalks and street closure in the downtown core for Al Fresco, the popular summer event, from the beginning of June to the end of August.

Sponsors will choose from the tête-à-tête design submissions. The sponsor's name and logo as well as the artist will be displayed on a plaque and attached to the table.

"We have been working behind the scenes on the plans for Al Fresco and looking for ways to add colour and vibrancy to the streets.
