A StoryWalk® is an outdoor reading experience where a children's book is deconstructed and the pages of the book are placed in different locations for families to follow a trail and finish the book.

During the month of June, pages from the book *I Want My Hat Back by Jon Klassen* will be displayed in the windows of 13 downtown businesses. Starting at the Belleville Public Library, participants will be guided by a walking map to read the book one page - and one storefront - at a time.
