Having taught thousands of people how to successfully throw an axe, their coaches can teach all skill levels from beginner to competitive. With no venues locally at the time, he felt that the sport of Axe Throwing was something that he wanted to share in our community. Ded Eye has a pending partnership with the International Axe Throwing Federation (IATF) and they look forward to continuing to build a community of axe throwers that not only compete but also support each other whether cheering from the sidelines or out and about in regular life.
