## Welcoming Streets Initiative Recognized with Provincial Award

Belleville, Ontario, April 26, 2022 - The Downtown District Business Improvement Association (BIA) is pleased to announce that the Welcoming Streets Initiative, is the recipient of the 2022 **Ontario Business Improvement Area Association** (OBIAA) Achievement Award in the category of Advocacy and Policy.

The award recognizes BIAs who have exhibited leadership in advocacy, innovation, government relations, stakeholder/community engagement, addressing social issues like homelessness and crime, equity, and inclusion and legislative changes.

The award was presented to Downtown District BIA Executive Director, Luisa Sorrentino, at the OBIAA Conference in Niagara Falls yesterday (April 25).

Launched in June of 2021, the BIA's Welcoming Streets Initiative has assisted vulnerable individuals in the area, and created a more collaborative and safe environment by addressing concerns identified by business owners and the public.
