**Belleville, Ont., Jan. 28, 2025** – The Downtown Belleville District Business Improvement Area (DBIA) announces that the Welcoming Streets Program will conclude its operations following the expiration of its contract under the Community Safety and Policing (CSP) grant effective March 31, 2025.

Since its inception in 2021, the Welcoming Streets Program has been a cornerstone of support for downtown Belleville, offering innovative and compassionate assistance to local businesses and individuals experiencing challenges related to mental health, substance use, and homelessness. Funded by Hastings County, the City of Belleville, and most recently the CSP grant through Belleville Police Services, the program has made a lasting impact on the downtown core.

As the program transitions to a close, the DBIA will continue to focus on its primary mandate of promoting and supporting local businesses. The organization encourages social service agencies and community partners to continue building on the success of the Welcoming Streets Program by carrying forward its mission of creating a safe, inclusive, and supportive downtown environment.
